#### **Meaning of Communion**

Today we come together to receive the body and blood, the real presence of our Savior Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of sins. As the apostle Paul taught his church, whoever eats the bread and drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord.

\*Why do we say the <u>words of institution</u> regarding communion? To institute something is to start or establish something. The Words of Institution are words by which Jesus started and established His Supper. This is also when the real presence of Christ comes into the elements of bread and wine.
