First Lesson

P: Finally, Pilate handed Jesus over to them to be crucified. So, the soldiers took charge of Him.

C: *Carrying his own cross, he went out to the place of the Skull (which in Aramaic is called Golgotha).*

P: Here they crucified him, and with him two others--one on each side and Jesus in the middle.

C: *Pilate had a notice prepared and fastened to the cross. It read: JESUS OF NAZARETH, THE KING OF THE JEWS.*

P: Many of the Jews read this sign, for the place where Jesus was crucified was near the city.

C: *The chief priests of the Jews protested to Pilate, "Do not write 'The King of the Jews,' but that this man claimed to be king of the Jews."*

P: Pilate answered, "What I have written, I have written."

C: *They took his undergarment which was seamless, woven in one piece from top to bottom.*

P: "Let's not tear it," they said; "Let's decide by lot who will get it." This happened that the scripture might be fulfilled which said, "They divided my garments among them and cast lots for my clothing."

C: *Near the cross of Jesus stood his mother, his mother's sister, Mary the wife of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene.*

P: Jesus said to his mother, "Dear woman, here is your son," and to the disciple, "Here is your mother." From that time on, this disciple took her into his home.

C: *Knowing that all was now completed, and so that the Scripture would be fulfilled, Jesus said, "I am thirsty."*

P: A jar of wine vinegar was there, so they soaked a sponge in it, put the sponge on a stalk of the hyssop plant, and lifted it to Jesus' lips.

C: *When he had received the drink, Jesus said, "It is finished." With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.*
